Secretary's Report

- There were twelve (12) attendees at tonight's meeting.
- There were no corrections or additions to March minutes. The minutes were read and approved by Mike Schmidt (1st) and Linda Farnsworth (2nd).

Treasurer's Report

- Account balance as of April 14, 2009 is \$16,682.10
- Treasurer's report was read and approved by Terry Bittner (1st) and Rich Gorze (2nd).

Old Business

- Terry Bittner gave the final report for the reverse raffle. The revenue/profit was \$15,406.00. This was the second highest raffle event in profits. The slide presentation and overheads used for the reverse raffle were used at no additional cost to the boosters. The slide presentation was well received. There was a suggestion to make DVD copies of the slide presentation for sale next year. It was also suggested to cut the bidding times for next year. The 2010 reverse raffle will be held on Saturday, March 15.
- The boosters are still in need of another used/new refrigerator for the concession stand. Several teams (soccer, tennis, cheer, and wrestling) have already contacted the boosters about manning the concession stand for Friday night games.
- The dirt was delivered and applied to the baseball/softball fields. They did a great job spreading the dirt. Fields are looking good.

New Business

- Craig has been contacting the Pioneer Co. regarding the purchase of a broom/sweeper to help with the compacting problem on the new football field. The prices range from \$3,800-4,200.00.
- The new bat has been purchased for the baseball team.
- There was a coach's (Val Baughman) request for new travel bags for the girl's varsity soccer team. The current bags were purchased in 2007. The cost for new bags would be ~\$500-600. A motion was passed to purchase the bags and all were in favor. They may need new bags for the JV team also. This request was put on hold to see the final cost of the Varsity bags.
- The boosters need a chairperson to run the 2010 programs. John Carmiagno has agreed to help with the lay outs. Bob Manthey is willing to do the printing. The Raftry's have put all the information on a disc. Please contact Tom Detweiler if you are interested in chairing the fall programs.
