- Concession volunteers have filled all available nights. The first game will be handled by the girl's soccer team. Second game will be covered by boy's soccer team.
- Facilities: Craig has received one bid for the fencing on the new fields. He is getting quotes for a 6 foot fence, approximately 1400 feet. He is still waiting on other bids. The new fields have been seeded and paid. The new scoreboard is up! There will be training on how to run the new board this Thursday during the girl's soccer scrimmage. All new lockers have been installed in both the boys and girls locker rooms. The showers have been upgraded in the boy's locker room and hope to have the girl's showers upgraded by spring.
