Secretary's Report

- April minutes were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report

- Treasurer's report was given. The balance as of May 12, 2008 is \$10,272.39. Treasurer's report was read and approved.

Old Business

- Craig Walkup gave update on facility updates:
 - Expansion on the girl's locker room is in progress. New lockers will be installed May 29. Westfield Group is donating the new carpet.
 - Craig will be meeting with the company installing the new basketball lifts.
 - Earth is being moved for new practice fields. There was a minor set back when a "dry pond" was discovered. They are working around it.
 - Cloverleaf had 3 conference champion teams this year. It's been a long time since 3 banners were won in a school year. Congratulations to Brenda Hewitt and the boy's tennis team!!
 - Boy Scouts built the benches being used around the new tennis courts. They are very nice and working out well for both teams and spectators.

New Business

- Concession stands made ~\$1200 for spring season. They received many complements from other schools for being open during track meets.
- A request from the football coach, Kevin Gault, was made for the purchase of a linemen shoot. The total cost is \$2,500. He asked for the boosters' support of \$2,000. The Linemen Shoot is made of heavy duty materials, on wheels for easy moving, and should last ~20 years. Linda Farnsworth motioned to grant the request with a second from Mike Schmidt. Motion passed with all in favor.
- Baseball's Coach Bill Rodman had a loan request of \$650 for the purchase of a used lawn tractor. He asked for a loan from the booster club until the baseball team money comes in from a "Texas Hold'em" fundraiser. Linda Farnsworth made the motion to grant Bill's request with a second from Linda Kovad. Motion passed.
- Another request for the purchase of a Self Contained Drinking System made by Rubbermaid. It can be used by football, baseball, soccer, etc. Mike Schmidt will look into the purchase. Cost is ~\$500.00. Bill Rodman made the motion to purchase and Linda Farnsworth seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- Mike Schmidt informed the Boosters that pay-to-play would be increasing for the 2008/2009 school year. The HS students will pay \$200.00 and the MS students will pay \$100.00.
- This will be Beth Meadows last year as Booster's secretary. Best of luck to her!!
- Work should begin on the Cloverleaf sports programs for next year. Needed: advertisements and flyers to businesses/companies. There may be an increase in the cost.
