- Concession stand is doing well and completely booked for the season with volunteers. Volunteers should arrive around 5:30 for early set up and be operational by 6:00pm. Concession stand has been making ~\$350.00/night.
- The Sports Programs are in and look great! The Mail Room in Medina did the printing. Volunteers are still needed to help sell programs at the games. Program sellers should arrive ~5:30pm.
- "CHS" window clings order should arrive by Wednesday. Sales can start at this Friday's football game.
- Forty (40) "CHS" window clings will be donated to the new family dinner along with a flyer about the All Sports Booster Club.
- Facilities updates by Craig Walkup;
